

## **Arizona Science Center plans Global Awareness Day festival**

Arizona Science Center will host its second annual Global Awareness Day from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday, featuring more than 18 local companies providing environmental demonstrations and activities.

"Learning to be environmentally responsible is top of mind for many people, especially in the dry Arizona desert," said Kristin Priscella, director of marketing and public relations at Arizona Science Center.

"It is amazing to learn about the impact that we as individuals can have, just by making a few simple changes to our daily routines."

Some of the companies that will be featured include a.k.a. Green, Animal Defense League of Arizona, APS, Audubon Arizona, Arizona Game and Fish Department, Adobe Mountain Wildlife Rehabilitation, Arizona Water Activists Karing for the Environment (AWAKE), Arizona Wilderness Coalition, c.i. Development Group, Chandler Gilbert Community College, Global Institute of Sustainability, Heifer International, Sierra Club, Southwest Wildlife, SRP Earthwise, the Phoenix Zoo, Valley Metro and Whole Foods.

General admission is \$9 for adults, and admission for children (ages 3-12) and seniors (62 and older) is \$7.

Admission to the Center's current featured exhibition, "CSI: Crime Scene Insects," is an additional \$2 for adults and \$1 for children and seniors.
